1 PURPOSE.

This Afghanistan Civil Aviation Authority (ACAA) Directive describes the procedure to amend the Afghan Civil Aviation Regulations subsequent to an amendment or change in national or international regulations and for listing and notifying differences to International Civil Aviation Organization.

The Islamic Republic of Afghanistan is signatory state of the Chicago Convention on International Civil Aviation. ACAA has agreed on adoption of international standards and procedures as well as on the obligation regarding deviations from international standards and procedures. This Directive is to comply with these obligations and with obligations to other international corporate bodies.

2 RELATED REGULATIONS

All Afghanistan Civil Aviation Regulations which are promulgated should be in compliance with ICAO SARPs and should be amended as per this directive.

3 COOPERATION

The representative of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan at the ICAO or in other international corporate bodies or ICAO focal point in the ACAA and the competent officials of the Afghan Civil Aviation Authority, and if applicable officials of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, shall cooperate with each other and ensure timely update the relevant departments for any change in ICAO Annexes, Documents etc..

4 COMPLIANCE PROCEDURE

4.1 ICAO

The representative of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan to the ICAO or ICAO focal point in the state observes all activities of the ICAO regarding the development of ICAO Annexes, standards, recommended practices and documents. Already during the drafting phase ACAA needs regarding the field of civil aviation can be considered as well as the Afghanistan Civil Aviation Regulations to be checked for compliance with the drafted ICAO regulations.

After issuance of ICAO regulations, no matter what kind or hierarchy in the ICAO regulation system, the Afghanistan civil aviation regulations shall be checked by the competent official of the Afghan civil aviation administration, if they comply with the requirement set by the ICAO regulation.



4.2 National requirements and requirements of other international corporate bodies

If Afghanistan civil aviation regulations deviate from any ICAO regulation, the competent official reports this to the Director General of the ACAA. A suitable solution for making Afghanistan civil aviation regulations consistent with the relevant ICAO regulation or sound reasons for the deviation shall be offered.

The Director General of the ACAA may change the relevant Afghanistan civil aviation regulation within their subject-matter jurisdiction or propose a favourable change to the relevant body.

5 DIFFERENCES OF AFGHANISTAN CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS TO INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS

If a deviation of Afghanistan civil aviation legislation or regulations is ascertained and a change is either not desirable nor enforceable for any reason, the Director General of the ACAA will authorize the representative of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan to the ICAO to give notification to the ICAO of the differences between its own practice and that established by the international standard without any delay.

The ACAA maintains a database with a list of all deviations of the Afghanistan civil aviation regulations from ICAO regulations.
